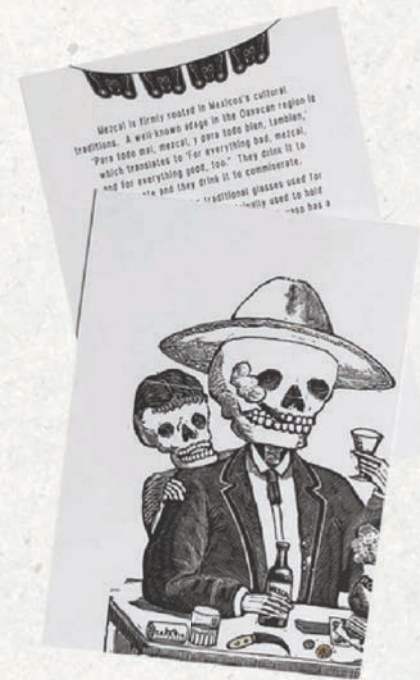

Veladoras Mezcal Sipping Glass

Origin: Oaxaca, Mexico

These glasses were traditionally used in Catholic churches to contain prayer candles. Each vaso has a crucifix imprinted on its base reflecting its original purpose.

Somewhere along the line, churchgoers in Oaxaca began "borrowing" them after church and using them to drink Mezcal; a whole new tradition was born in connection to the Vaso Veladoras.

The relation between where the glasses come from, their original purpose and the religious traditions of Mezcal in regards to where and when it is drunk, serves a deeper meaning when drinking from one of these vasos; the idea being that you are reminded of your mortality with every sip and each sip is to honour or celebrate a specific moment/occasion.

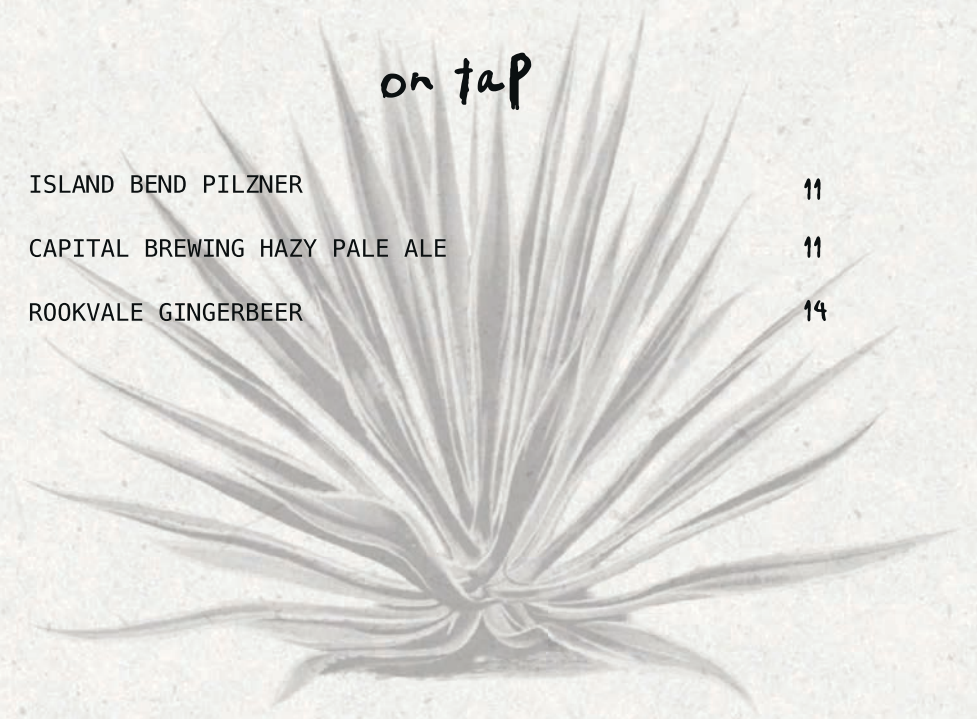

At Cocina our list is made of only 100% agave tequilas. Some commercial tequila companies make a "mixto" or part sugar product which produces a different flavour.

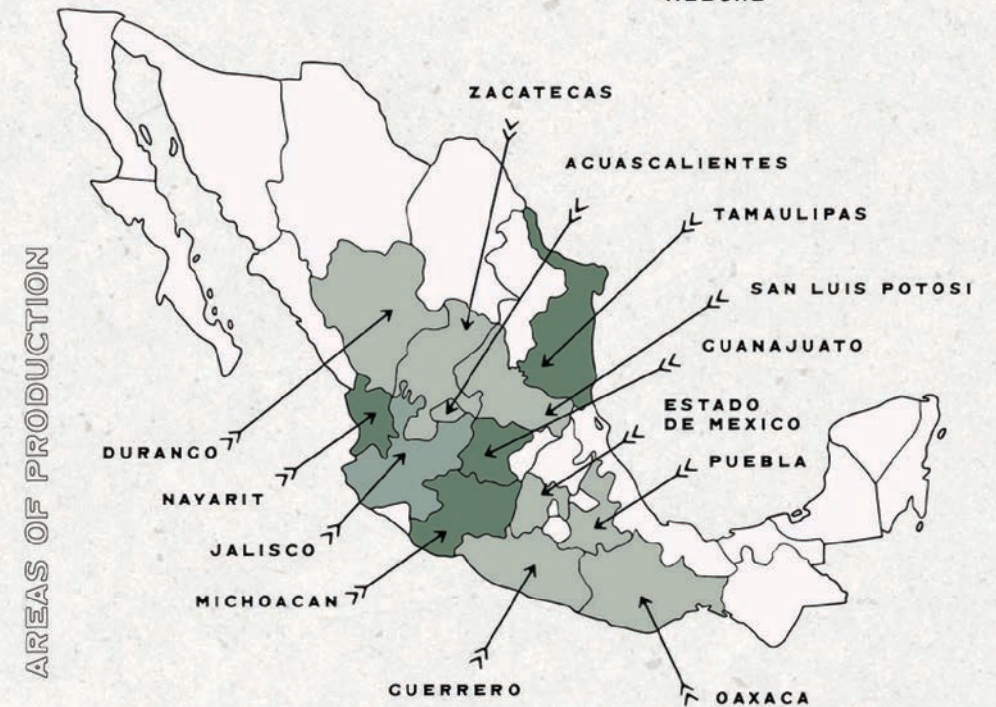
High quality tequilas and mezcals are meant to be sipped and enjoyed, not shot, so....

Take it slow. Relax, sip & enjoy!

TEQUILA	<p>Tequila agave, is an agave plant that is native to Jalisco, Mexico. The high production of sugars named agavins, mostly fructose, in the core of the plant is the main characteristic that makes it suitable for distilling to create Tequila.</p> <p>The tequila agave is native to the states of Jalisco, Colima, Nayarit and Aguascalientes in Mexico.</p>	TIPOS DE AGAVE
	<p>BLANCO Silver, plato, crystal or white. Agave Azul's purest form - unaged in stainless steel or neutral oak.</p>	
	<p>REPOSADO Rested Tequila. Aged from 2-12 months usually in white oak barrels which enhances depth and flavour.</p>	
	<p>AÑEJO Aged from 1-3 years in oak barrels of a max 600L capacity. Rounder, softer and best for sipping.</p>	
	<p>EXTRA AÑEJO Aged 3+ years. Attracts all palates. Rich oak flavours reminiscent of darker spirits.</p>	
MEZCAL	<p>Mezcal can be made from more than 30 varieties of agave. The most common variety used is Espadin which accounts to almost 90% of mezcal. Tobalé, tobaziche, tepeztate & arroqueño are also popular.</p>

TEQUILA AND MEZCAL

Both tequila and mezcal are made from the harvested core of the agave plant. However, that's where the similarities in production end. Tequila is produced by steaming the agave inside industrial ovens before being distilled two or three times in copper pots.



Mezcal, on the other hand, is cooked inside earthen pits that are lined with lava rocks and filled with wood and charcoal before being distilled in clay pots. While some large-scale mezcal producers have adopted modern methods, artisanal mezcal makers continue to use this more traditional method, which is the source of the smokiness commonly associated with mezcal.
